In November 2018, RCGS Resolute, a purpose built polar expedition passenger vessel, will join Akademik Ioffe and Akademik Sergey Vavilov under the One Ocean Expeditions banner, offering the most capable, safe and exclusive expedition cruise fleet in the industry.

Built in Rauma, Finland the same shipyard as Akademik Ioffe & Akademik Sergey Vavilov, RCGS Resolute offers modern stabilization and unsurpassed ice classification (Lloyds 1AS) compliant with the new Polar Code. Between all three vessels One Ocean Expeditions is perfectly equipped with the right hardware and programming to offer our full range of activities, guiding our adventurous guests on their quest to imagine, explore and discover the world's most remote and inspiring regions.

Based on popular demand One Ocean Expeditions has built new product expansion between Antarctica and the High Arctic onboard RCGS Resolute. New itineraries available in the spring of 2019 range from the Chilean Fjords, the West and East Coasts of Central America (Costa Rica, Panama, Cuba) including a transit through the Panama Canal. Those interested in exploring the Viking trade routes of Scotland and Iceland can choose to spend 7 nights on our expedition golf voyage including some of the world's most prestigious and acclaimed golf courses, expedition style. For our more traditional wildlife, photography and adventure voyages, the coastal highlands of Northern Scotland offer incredible vistas and expansive hiking opportunities. Wrapping up the spring season with a comprehensive exploration of Iceland, Scotland and the Faroe Islands; guests may simply just choose to stay onboard a while! Voyage Descriptions — Canada's East Coast 2018

- **EAST COAST GOLF EXPEDITION: FIDDLES & STICKS** North America's first expedition golf voyage offering opportunities to play at some of the finest golf courses in Canada — several of which feature in the 'Top 100' golf courses in the world! Golfers from around the world are drawn by the superb challenges offered and the magnificent coastal settings. Relaxation has never been easier between courses. Each day our expedition plan unfolds onto a new course, where clubs and lunches are transferred ashore via zodiac. Imagine approaching the 1st hole by way of the shoreline! Confirmed course locations include Cabot Links, Cabot Cliffs, Crowbush, and Highland Links. We even hope to play a round on the picturesque island of Les Illes de la Madeleine, located in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.
- **CANADA'S EAST COAST: FINS & FIDDLES** Immerse yourself in everyday 18th century life in a French fortress in Louisbourg, Nova Scotia, then set sail into the North Atlantic on a small, ice-strengthened expedition ship while savouring fresh local lobster. Wake up to the mystique of the remote Sable Island, where wild horses run free on grassy dunes and grey seals bark from sandy shores of waters scattered with 350 shipwrecks. Explore Canadian history in genteel Charlottetown, PEI, where the pivotal conference that set Canada's Confederation in motion was set. Kayak or stand-up paddle board across glassy waters, and cruise on a guided zodiac tour, or head ashore to hike or cycle. In Newfoundland and Labrador, sail alongside soaring fjord walls streaming with waterfalls in Gros Morne National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Drop in for wine and cheese at a petite outpost of France off Canada's coast, then along the coastlines of Iles-de-la-Madeleine and Anticosti Island in Quebec. All optional activities are included in the voyage price.
- **LABRADOR & TORNGAT EXPLORER** This voyage links several fascinating historic locations on Canada's East Coast, with an incredible transition from the East Coast provinces of Canada to the heart of the Arctic. Opportunities include: a hike to the world heritage Tablelands National Park (a place where the Earth's mantle is exposed on the surface), a visit to remote Moravian mission outposts, isolated fishing ports, Basque settlements and the French-built Fortress of Louisbourg (a National Historic Site of Canada). Exploring the breathtaking wilderness of Torngat Mountains National Park offers incredible photographic opportunities as well as a range of wildlife and is one of the only places in Canada where it is possible to see a black bear and polar bear in the same day!

THE CANADIAN ARCTIC & WESTERN GREENLAND

Voyage Descriptions — Arctic 2018

The Canadian Arctic offers an epic, life changing opportunity when explored by small expedition cruise ship. Years spent exploring these waters provide us with an intrinsic understanding of both the ice and the wildlife areas popular with whales, seals and of course the elusive hunters of the North — polar bears.

- **BAFFIN ISLAND – JEWEL OF THE ARCTIC** Baffin Island is one of the last great wilderness regions on the planet and the focus of our outstanding expedition. From Iqaluit we explore up the east coast of Baffin Island discovering deep fjords, soaring mountains, immense glacial systems, remote Inuit communities, and incredible wildlife. This is small ship expedition cruising at its best.
- **HIGH ARCTIC EXPLORER** This 9-night stunning journey is the perfect combination of wildlife, history and scenery. The long hours of daylight give us maximum time to explore known wildlife hot spots including one of the largest migratory bird sanctuaries in the world, Prince Leopold Island. Landing areas include Grise Fiord, Craig Harbour, Dundas Harbour and Beechey Island, all located above 64th parallel. Along the ice floe edge we encounter beluga and bowhead whales and hope to encounter the mythical narwhal. Sightings of polar bears can be expected at numerous locations throughout the voyage.
- **PATHWAYS TO FRANKLIN** The principal focus of this 9-night expedition is the history of Arctic exploration and the early quest for the Northwest Passage. The story of Sir John Franklin's expedition from the mid 18th century and the enduring mystery of their fate have gripped the imagination for more than 170 years. A new chapter in this tale was written in September 2014 when the Victoria Strait Expedition, a joint government/private endeavour (of which One Ocean Expeditions is a proud partner) was successful in the find of Sir John Franklin's HMS Erebus. We navigate through these waters and wonder about the fate of these early Arctic explorers.
- **CLASSIC NORTHWEST PASSAGE** The Northwest Passage is one of the world's most iconic maritime routes of discovery. This 12-night voyage covers the full spectrum of Arctic scenery, culture, history and wildlife — making it a much-loved classic. We follow in the footsteps of the early Arctic explorers such as Franklin, Amundsen and Larsen, exploring the vast archipelago of islands and channels that create Canada's High Arctic region. This is the home of the polar bear, barren land grizzly, muskox, caribou, walrus, beluga and possibly even the narwhal. There are several variations to this itinerary — east to west, west to east — linking the west coast of Greenland to Cambridge Bay, in the heart of the Northwest Passage.
- **WEST GREENLAND & BAFFIN ISLAND EXPLORER** An exploration of the wildlife, culture and spectacular scenery in Western Greenland and the Canadian Arctic. From Kangerlussuaq on the west coast of Greenland to Iqaluit on the east coast of Baffin Island, this 11-day adventure sails through a spectacular wilderness of glaciers, mountains, fjords and breathtaking icebergs. Along the way, Inuit settlements of both Greenland and Canada will open eyes to the rich and unique cultures that have survived in this harsh landscape for centuries.





SPITSBERGEN

Voyage Descriptions — Arctic 2018

Spitsbergen and the Svalbard archipelago offer tremendous wildlife and birdlife experiences, as well as a fascinating lesson in glaciology. The islands are the northernmost inhabited places on the planet and would be permanently locked in ice if not for the moderating influence of the Atlantic Gulf Stream. Our series of voyages focus on the western quarter of the island group. This area has the highest concentration of wildlife and places of historic and scenic interest in the archipelago. The unique ice capabilities of our ships allow us to venture to the edge of the permanent Arctic pack ice where few other vessels can, at around 80 degrees north latitude. It is in this vicinity we typically enjoy our best encounters with polar bears.

- **SPITSBERGEN ENCOUNTER** On this 9-night voyage we focus our attention on the upper northwest islands of Spitsbergen — the largest island in the Svalbard archipelago. Sailing along the coast we visit numerous bird colonies and enjoy regular encounters with bearded and ringed seals. Days are busy with shore excursions to places of historic interest, visits to wildlife colonies, viewing the exquisite native flora and soaking up stunning Arctic landscapes. Short or long hikes on shore are another highlight, along with regular cruising in the zodiacs. Our voyage continues to remote Phippsøya, where we have our best chance to see polar bears. Returning south, we stop at Monaco Glacier and Liefdefjorden — another well known spot for bears.
- **SPITSBERGEN ENCOUNTER — PHOTOGRAPHY SYMPOSIUM** This brilliant voyage offers the same itinerary as One Ocean Expeditions' classic 9-night Spitsbergen Encounter with all the same great guides and educational elements. Unique to this departure is a custom program designed for photography enthusiasts. This program runs parallel to our daily off-ship excursions and activities. The photography team, led by Nikon master and award-winning photographer Daisy Gilardini, provides practical guidance and deep insight. Special excursions will include early mornings and late evenings chasing the gorgeous Arctic light. The program is open to photographers of all abilities and is included as part of the voyage.

Towering glaciers, amazing wildlife encounters with penguins, whales and seals, snow-covered landscapes, enormous icebergs and the option to choose your favourite activities every day, characterize travelling with One Ocean Expeditions. Our exciting expeditions include flights from Punta Arenas, Chile or the option to sail across the Drake Passage to Antarctica, providing great diversity and appeal to those seeking a truly comprehensive Antarctic experience. Our expedition ships offer a platform similar to that of a floating wilderness lodge, which we reposition every day to yet another exciting location. We break into small special interest groups, discovering Antarctica and its remarkable wildlife through hikes onshore, zodiac cruising and photography. For the more adventurous, overnight camping and sea kayaking options are available. Visits to historic huts and working research stations add another dimension to the voyage. One Ocean Expeditions is proud to continually improve the comforts found onboard and to ensure maximum relaxation on your voyage of a lifetime. Extensive upgrades across all passenger areas and cabins onboard Akademik Ioffe and Akademik Sergey Vavilov will be in place for Antarctica 2018-2019. If joining RCGS Resolute, our guests will be pleased with the expanded menu offerings, additional viewing lounges, and expansive wellness program.

Voyage Descriptions – One Ocean Navigator / Akademik Ioffe, Antarctica 2018-2019

For many, a voyage to Antarctica is truly the trip of a lifetime. Once there, you should choose how your Antarctic experience unfolds. If watching penguins is your priority — then we will set you up next to a busy rookery. Maybe a long hike to a snowy peak is the real reason you came all this way. We make it happen. Photographing icebergs? You will never tire of it. We achieve all of this through exceptional customer service by having the highest staff to passenger ratio in the industry. This season, One Ocean Navigator/Akademik Ioffe will operate a series of 'classic' Antarctic voyages departing from Ushuaia, Argentina. We also include several new itineraries incorporating flights from Punta Arenas, Chile to Antarctica or to Stanley, Falkland Islands, saving time on sea crossings. Expeditions range from 10 to 19 nights in duration, visiting all of the much-loved locations and a few lesser known gems we have discovered over the years.

- **FALKLAND ISLANDS, SOUTH GEORGIA, ANTARCTICA** Available in 16 or 18 night itineraries, with options to choose different embarkation points ranging from Stanley, Falkland Islands, Ushuaia, Argentina, and even King George Island, Antarctica. This is our most far-reaching polar journey and includes visits to three different regions. The sub-Antarctic Falkland Islands and the island of South Georgia are home to an abundance of unique wildlife. There are penguin rookeries with more than 100,000 nesting birds and the beaches are covered with fur seals and elephant seals. Seabirds, including many of the albatross species, call these islands home. Both regions feature fascinating history and stunning scenery. To the south lies Antarctica — the frozen continent and our final destination on this remarkable voyage. Icebergs in all shapes and sizes fill the waters and more unique wildlife can be found living in sizeable colonies. The waters are full of life and we frequently encounter whales including humpback, minke and orca. Travelling this far — you might as well stay a while!
- **ANTARCTICA – OFF THE BEATEN TRACK** This comprehensive and diverse voyage offers zodiac cruising, onshore walks and hikes, visits to wildlife colonies, exploration of historic sites/scientific stations, and excursions to discover the beautiful bays and landing sites found along the Antarctic Peninsula. This voyage combines untouched Antarctica and plenty of options to enjoy an exciting range of outdoor offerings. Love outdoor activity? So do we! Only on this 12-night voyage can our guests participate in ski touring, expedition snowshoeing, sea kayaking with an overnight camping option and our expedition field photography workshops. Our entry into Antarctica is one of the first of the season, and is met with pristine conditions following the heavy snowfall of the Antarctic winter. This is untouched wilderness at its finest.
- **CHRISTMAS IN ANTARCTICA** December provides maximum hours of daylight as we experience Antarctica during the summer solstice. By starting this voyage in Ushuaia, Argentina and disembarking on King George Island, Antarctica, time is optimized for the best experiences. Over the course of 10 nights, we visit many of the classic locations along the Antarctic Peninsula providing a great variety of exciting activities both on and off the ship. Traditionally, this departure has been very popular with families as it falls over the holiday season. Join us for the most wonderful 'white Christmas' you could ever imagine surrounded by icebergs, crystal clear waters, astonishing wildlife and create memories that will last a lifetime.

Voyage Descriptions – One Ocean Voyager / Akademik Sergey Vavilov, Antarctica 2018-2019

Launched 2 years ago, these unique voyages have proven very popular with those seeking to maximize their time spent in Antarctica. By flying from Punta Arenas, Chile to the gateways of Port Stanley in the Falkland Islands, or King George Island in Antarctica, we save several days of open ocean crossings. Rather than shortening the total Antarctic experience and operating hurried 6 or 7 day voyages, we add these 'saved days' to the expedition and see even more. We don't know anyone that ever went all the way to Antarctica to rush the experience. This is a refreshing new angle on the 'air access to Antarctica' concept and unique to One Ocean Expeditions.

- **SOUTH GEORGIA IN-DEPTH – PHOTOGRAPHIC SYMPOSIUM** This 14-night itinerary features incredible wildlife encounters, fascinating history and gorgeous scenery. For lovers of wildlife, remote destinations and epic scenery, this is the trip to choose. Only on these voyages will you have the privilege to spend more consecutive days exploring South Georgia. Here you will witness what has often been described as the 'greatest wildlife show on Earth'. Unique to this departure is a custom program designed for photography. This program runs parallel to our daily off ship excursions and activities. The photography team, led by Nikon master and award-winning photographer, Daisy Gilardini, provides practical guidance and deep insight. Special excursions will include early mornings and late evenings chasing the gorgeous Antarctic light. The program is open to photographers of all abilities and is included as part of the voyage.
- **SOUTH GEORGIA IN-DEPTH** This popular 16-night voyage offers the best South Georgia has to offer. Only on this voyage will you have the privilege of spending more consecutive days exploring South Georgia. Here you will witness what has often been described as the 'greatest wildlife show on Earth'. The story of Sir Ernest Shackleton and the Endurance expedition from over a century ago is forever connected to the island. Today, the place teems with wildlife on a jaw-dropping scale. King penguin rookeries are home to more than a hundred-thousand birds, seals cover the beaches and nesting seabirds fill the skies. This voyage embarks in Stanley, Falkland Islands and disembarks in Ushuaia, Argentina.
- **ANTARCTICA IN-DEPTH** This voyage encompasses 2 additional days of exploration in Antarctica without adding to the total length of the voyage. We achieve this by flying back from King George Island (Antarctica) to South America at the end of the voyage, saving 2 days on the return sea crossing. Those 2 days 'saved' are spent exploring in Antarctica. This equals more time on shore, more time in the zodiacs and more time spent in the company of our expert guides.
- **ANTARCTICA, SOUTH GEORGIA, FALKLAND ISLANDS** December is a beautiful time to experience Antarctica. We enjoy extended daylight hours, the wildlife colonies are busy and as the sea ice continues to break up, our range of landing sites expands even further. We fly from South America to Antarctica in a little over 2 hours where we board our ship before exploring the glaciated coastline of the Antarctic Peninsula.
- **QUEST FOR THE ANTARCTIC CIRCLE** This unique expedition provides a modern twist on a much loved classic. Utilizing our decades of experience, this innovative itinerary allows us to reach our objective of the Antarctic Circle in just 11 days. From Punta Arenas, Chile we fly to the embarkation point of Stanley, Falkland Islands. Crossing south to Antarctica we witness the magnificent pelagic seabirds of the southern ocean, including the wandering albatross. This ocean habitat is a fascinating ecosystem in its own right. Navigating our way towards the Circle, we enjoy 7 days with the opportunity of off-ship explorations along the Antarctic Peninsula, visiting a large number of landing sites and cruising among the ice floes in our zodiac boats.

- **ANTARCTICA – DEEP SOUTH** This special journey takes us further south than at any other time in the season. By flying to King George Island in Antarctica at the start of the voyage, we save 2 days on the ocean crossing. The time we save by flying south allows for a more substantial exploration below the Antarctic Circle. Here we witness stunning landscapes, sizeable Adelie penguin rookeries and large flat-topped tabular icebergs that drift north from the Bellingshausen Sea. We anticipate exciting ice navigation when pushing this far south.
- **ANTARCTICA, SOUTH GEORGIA, FALKLAND ISLANDS** The towering peaks and immense glacial systems of the Antarctic Peninsula are home to a great abundance of wildlife which we observe on shore, from the zodiacs and the ship. Large penguin rookeries are found at several locations and we encounter seals and whales in the iceberg filled waterways. Opportunities to visit historic huts and active science stations add further interest. We explore on shore through guided walks which may last up to several hours. Or if you prefer to sit and observe the penguins as they come and go from the water — why not? The more active may choose the sea kayaking option and experience a whole new side of Antarctica.
- **ANTARCTICA DEEP SOUTH** This special journey takes you further south than at any other time in the season. By flying to King George Island in Antarctica at the start of the voyage, we save 2 days on the ocean crossing. The time we save by flying south, allows for a more substantial exploration below the Antarctic Circle. Here we witness stunning landscapes, sizable Adelie penguin rookeries and large flat-topped tabular icebergs that drift north from the Bellingshausen Sea. We always anticipate exciting ice navigation when we push this far south.
- **MARINE MAMMALS OF ANTARCTICA** March is a time of great activity in Antarctic waters and historically we encounter a higher concentration of whales during this period. They are busy feeding prior to their annual migrations to tropical waters. However, scientists are now discovering that some whale species remain in the ice-free sections of Antarctica over winter. On this voyage we plan to visit several known locations along the Antarctic Peninsula that are the focus of long-term research projects by esteemed academic institutions including the University of California (Santa Cruz), California Ocean Alliance and the Australian Antarctic Division's Marine Mammal Centre. We are joined on the ship by several world-renowned cetacean (whale) experts and observe their important scientific fieldwork in close proximity.

Built in Rauma, Finland, RCGS Resolute has a specially built hull with increased steel and an ice class rating of Lloyds 1AS. In addition to exceptional ice class, superb stabilization and all the comforts of the world's most capable passenger expedition cruise vessel, One Ocean Expeditions brings all small group activities to life. Enjoy hiking, zodiac cruising, ski touring (AOTBT), photography, wildlife viewing, snowshoeing, camping, and sea kayaking. Add in One Ocean Expeditions' renowned wellness program, which offers yoga, massage and a well stocked gymnasium, and even the most discerning regime can be maintained. Following all of these exciting activities, guests can choose to relax in one of many incredible viewing areas, inside or out. Casual dining with exceptional menu options are paired with an international wine and beverage list.

- **ANTARCTIC PENINSULA ADVENTURE** This classic 10-night voyage features many of the well-known landing sites such as Neko Harbour, Paradise Harbour, Orne Harbour, Cuverville Island and the Errera Channel — and ice conditions permitting, we hope to transit the spectacular Lemaire Channel. Pleneau Island, Petermann Island and the iceberg-filled Penola Strait are all possibilities south of the Lemaire. A further highlight will be a visit to the enchanting South Shetland Islands. Seabirds, including many of the albatross species call these islands home, nesting and raising their young in this wild and remote environment. Over the course of 10 nights, we visit many of the classic locations along the Antarctic Peninsula, providing a great variety of exciting activities both on and off the ship. - **JOURNEY BELOW THE ANTARCTIC CIRCLE** This remote stretch of the Antarctic Peninsula is visited for just a few short months each year. From January onwards, seasonal ice conditions give us our best chance of achieving our objective — crossing the Antarctic Circle. Here we witness expansive landscapes, sizeable Adelie penguin rookeries and we hope to see the large tabular icebergs that have drifted north from the Bellingshausen Sea. We always anticipate exciting ice navigation on this expedition. Detaille Island, below the Circle is a spectacular location. The snowy peaks which surround us, soar more than 2,000 meters above the ice-strewn waters. We aim to cross 66 degrees, 33 minutes south of latitude, which officially marks the position of the Antarctic Circle on the global map. We then return north, along the heavily glaciated coastline of the Antarctic Peninsula, passing through the Argentine, Fish and Yalour Island archipelagos along the way and into the Gerlache Strait and Danco coast region.
- **CHILEAN FJORDS** If travelling to the ends of the Earth, why not travel back up through the Chilean Fjords? The incredible coastline of Chile offers unparalleled views, wildlife, activities, and even the potential of following the humpback whale migration from Antarctica. This 13-night voyage provides a tremendous opportunity to explore areas otherwise inaccessible by land based excursions. Waking up to a new expedition stop each morning encourages us to dust off our cameras and board the zodiacs, embracing the unknown.
